# How can you tell if someone has given their consent?





- Agreeing to one type of sexual activity (such as kissing) does not mean that a person is agreeing to other sex acts.
- Everyone has the right to change their mind at any point.





You can never assume someone is consenting just because they haven't said NO...

...or because you think you see something in their body language...

**ASK BEFORE YOU DO ANYTHING**

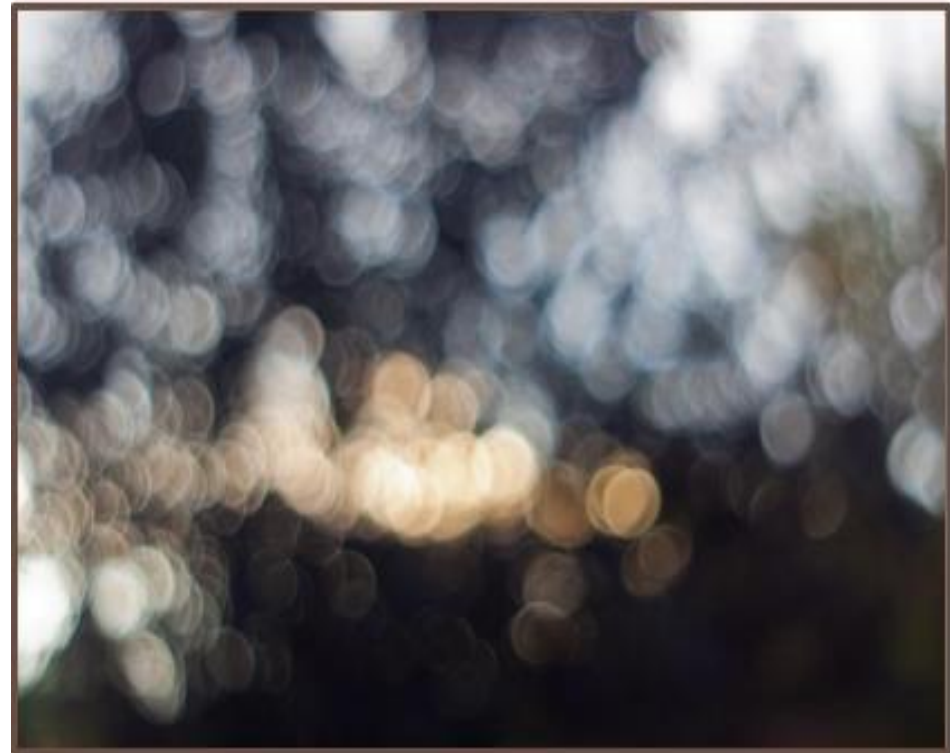


Never assume that there is consent just because you're on a date or in a relationship.





If someone is drunk or high,  
they can't consent to sex.





Consent is not about forcing,

shaming,  
or begging

someone to have sex





Saying NO should never be treated as a game or that someone is “playing hard to get.”

**NO = NO**



Engaging in a sexual act without the other person's consent is

**SEXUAL ASSAULT OR RAPE**
