

Our mission is to empower orphans and vulnerable children to reach their full potential, and our vision is a family for every child in our lifetime.

#### **Our Initiatives:**

Miracle Foundation has two primary ways we achieve our vision:

#### 1) We unite children with families

Children do not belong in orphanages, they belong in families. As we lead the transition of children away from institutions, our job is to make sure this work is done in a safe, stable, permanent and scalable way.

#### 2) We prevent children from entering the system

Every day around the world, social workers, caregivers and government officials make decisions that impact millions of vulnerable children. We provide highly specialized training and educational resources for these "boots on the ground" workers in the childcare ecosystem, allowing them to identify and support at-risk children long before separation is even an option.



# We unite children with families

All children are entitled to an education, nutrition, health and protection. Over the past twenty years, we have developed our proprietary Thrive Scale™ methodology, based on the UN Rights of the Child, to measure and improve life for more than 15,000 children in nearly 300 orphanages.

Today, our focus is helping these same children return to families. And so we've adapted our Thrive Scale<sup>TM</sup> to measure and activate a child's rights after they return home.

Across India, the Covid crisis sent 64% of children in orphanages home to their families. Miracle's rapid response provided much needed case management and family support to ensure children were safe at home and stayed at home.

Now, our proven processes are being shared with other countries, helping to bring more and more children home. Whether through training sessions with UNICEF or video resources on our website, we welcome all partners who can help us create a family for every child in our lifetime.



# We prevent children from entering the system

Every day around the world, social workers, caregivers, and government officials make decisions that impact millions of vulnerable children. That's why we work along with UNICEF and other partners to provide highly specialized training and educational resources for these "boots on the ground" workers in the childcare ecosystem.

Miracle Foundation has trained 2,400+ government officials and caregivers and activated community and youth led initiatives. All of this outreach works to identify and support atrisk children and vulnerable families long before formal interventions become a necessity. Our goal is to end the need for institutional care by stopping the flow of children before they enter the system.




# THRIVE SCALE METHODOLOGY



This revolutionary tool helps take the guesswork out of child placement.

Our Thrive Scale™ is how we measure, track and improve wellness areas during home assessments, both for orphaned children returning to families and for at-risk families who need support before child separation is necessary. This versatile tool is infinitely scalable, allowing us to train partners and share with case managers worldwide as we seek a family for every child in our lifetime.

Everyone knows children belong in families. But how do you bring them home safely? The Thrive Scale™ is the way.











#### New Ideas for Foster Care

Vulnerable children are not just confined to orphanages in far off parts of the world. Here in the United States, our Foster Care System has children bouncing from home to home an average of seven times, disrupting any sense of stability in these young lives.

After extensive research with both foster parents and case managers, working hard to understand the underlying issues and greatest challenges, our development team came up with a big idea. What emerged we call FosterShare<sup>TM</sup>: a revolutionary phone-based app that is changing the way case managers and foster families communicate. Now, following real-word beta testing at three top agencies in Texas, we will be launching FosterShare<sup>TM</sup> across the state in early 2022.





## Youth Take the Lead







Miracle Foundation believes in empowering young people, and this year, we launched many initiatives that put the ideas and energy of the world's youth at the forefront of our work.

Here in the USA, our Student Ambassador Program offered a 7-week campaign of social impact and leadership training to motivated high school students. Team building, fundraising, marketing, time management and mentorship was provided from our professional development staff. It's the stuff that future leaders are made of!

Around the world, our Youth For Social Impact project offered \$4000 grants and training to qualified, motivated participants. Like a series of mini pilot programs, this initiative helped develop Sinet's orphan community podcast in Cambodia, Grace's Life Skills Training program in Kenya, Adonyo's vocational training for girls in Uganda and so much more.
